VENDOR AGREEMENT: Fair Labor Chocolate

Child slave labor has been known to be a disturbing element in the chocolate industry since 1998, when UNICEF investigators found cacao farmers in Africa's Ivory Coast relied on labor from enslaved children to cultivate and harvest cocoa beans.

PCC sells chocolate only from vendors that provide assurance that child slave labor is prohibited and follow International Labor Organization (ILO) Fundamental Conventions (see <http://tinyurl.com/4dmo5em>).
